Petitioners seek quashing of an FIR No. 501 dated 11.08.2015 under Section 120-B/506 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 5, Gurgaon on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2 alleging that he had been criminally intimidated by the petitioners. Petitioner No. 1 happens to be the wife of complainant-respondent No. 2. Both of them have got their marriage dissolved.

The complainant has already put in appearance before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurgaon and stated that he has compromised the matter and does not want to pursue the case and has no objection in case FIR against both the petitioners, is quashed. Report of

Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurgaon has been received.

In view of the full bench judgment in **“Kulwinder Singh and other versus State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, this petition could be allowed by permitting the parties to compromise the matter.

Petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
