Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.343 dated 22.09.2015, under Sections 365, 506, 511, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat (Annexure P-1) is sought for on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Through order of this Court dated 26.08.2016 (wrongly typed as 26.08.2014), the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded, who in turn was directed to send a report to this Court.

As directed, report dated 07.10.2016 from the Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Mewat, has been received, as per which the parties recorded their statements before the Illaqa Magistrate in terms of the compromise.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance to the afore-referred FIR would be an abuse of the process of law

and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.343 dated 22.09.2015, under Sections 365, 506, 511, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat, and all proceedings arising therefrom.
