Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Randeep Singh @ Ravi in case FIR No.22 dated 2.3.2015 under Sections 21/61/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985, registered with Police Station Behram, Distt. SBS Nagar.

There is alleged recovery of 100 grams of *heroin* and 160 grams of intoxicating powder-Diacetylmorphine.

It is contended that seized quantity of 260 grams is marginally commercial in nature and the interim bail granted on 25.5.2015 was never misused apart from the fact that petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Bachitter Singh does not refute the aforesaid factual contents.

In view of the aforesaid without commenting on the merits of the case, the interim bail already granted on 25.05.2015 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
