This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 28.03.2015 registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Today the learned Additional Advocate General on

Instructions from ASI Gopal Singh states that out of 8 witnesses 2 have

already been examined and undertakes that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
