Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner who has been summoned as an additional accused under Section 319 Cr.PC to face trial in FIR No.101 dated 5.6.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 364-A,382,342,500 and 120-B IPC and Section 392 IPC added later on, PS Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

It was submitted that petitioner was ready and willing to face trial.

Vide order dated 23.2.2016 while issuing notice of motion it was directed that in the event of petitioner surrendering before the trial court within 10 days he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of trial court.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 23.2.2016 passed by this Court, petitioner surrendered before the trial court and was released on interim bail on 26.2.2016, which fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court, pursuant to the order dated 23.2.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.
