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Criminal Revision No. 4055 of 2012

NARINDER KUMAR V/S JAGTAR SINGH AND ANOTHER

Petitioner was convicted by the Trial Court vide judgment dated 18.3.2011 under section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay fine of ₹ 5,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. The appeal filed by the petitioner before the Appellate Court was also dismissed vide order dated 8.12.2012. Hence the present criminal revision.

The matter has been compromised between the parties. Today, petitioner-Narinder Kumar has brought and paid a sum of remaining ₹ 30,000/- in cash to respondent No.1-Jagtar Singh s/o Sh. Bakhtaur Singh. Respondent No.1-Jagtar Singh has placed on record photo-copy of his identity card as a mark of identification.

It may be added here that respondent No.1-Jagtar Singh (complainant) also stated that he does not have any other claim against the petitioner.

In view of the matter having been settled, as the offence is compoundable and according to the statement of complaint-Jagtar Singh, the complaint having been withdrawn necessarily the conviction and sentence

recorded by the Trial Court and upheld by the Appellate Court is set aside and the present criminal revision is disposed of as having become infructuous.
