JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Ramesh Kumar Bagga seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to register FIR under Sections 506 and 34 IPC against respondents No.4 and 5 who are allegedly extending threats repeatedly to kill the entire family of the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representation dated February 09, 2015 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice

on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-6) and if the allegations levelled in the said representation are *prima-facie* established, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
