Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Mukesh Kumar, Manager L&T Finance Limited alleging that the complainant Company had deputed Rajiv Sharma along with petitioner for recovery. The allegations against the petitioner are that he connived with his co-accused and misappropriated the amount received from the customers by not depositing the same with the Company. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f 16.1.2016.

As per the material gathered against the petitioner, he has allegedly caused a wrongful loss to the Company to the extent of Rs.2,00,000/-.

It has been urged by the counsel for the petitioner that Rajiv Sharma co-accused of the petitioner has been entrusted the job to collect dues of installments along with interest etc. His culpability along with the other similarly circumstanced accused is to be finally determined on appreciation of evidence. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for the entire period of trial.

Taking into consideration the period of detention and status of the investigation, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
