Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.90 dated 26.6.2013 under sections 21, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Samana, District Patiala.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It may be noticed that even on the previous dates i.e. on 1.2.2016, 27.11.2015, 1.10.2015, 21.8.2015 and 14.7.2015 none had appeared.
