This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for anticipatory bail of the petitioner in case FIR No. 55 dated 6.10.2015 under Sections 406/409/420/465/467/468/471/473,474,120-B IPC at Police Station Mansa Devi Complex, Panchkula.

The status report in the form of affidavit of Munish Sehgal, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Traffic) Panchkula has been filed. The same is taken on record.

As per the FIR the allegations against the petitioner are that he has committed various acts of forgery, cheating and for illegally encashing three FDRs of complainant for a sum of ₹3 lacs each.

Mr. Kuldeep Tewari, Additional Advocate General,

Haryana., on instructions from the Inspector Mohinder Singh states that since all the documents and the hand writing sample of the accused has been recovered, further interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary.

Be that as it may, in the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the interim order dated 25.5.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The Criminal Misc. petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
