Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Raghubir Singh Mohi in case FIR No. 108, dated 02.12.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 27/54/59 of Arms Act (Section 307, Indian Penal Code deleted), registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

As per allegations, the accused/petitioner had refused to pay a sum of Rs. 49,000/- to clear the credit of the shop of the complainant.

It is submitted that the parties have since settled the dispute vide a written compromise deed dated 17.02.2016 (Annexure P-6) and a separate petition has been filed for quashing the aforesaid FIR itself, based on the compromise, is listed for hearing before this Court on 30.03.2016.

Learned counsel for the complainant has acknowledged the terms of the compromise.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Bahadur Ram, states that after completion of the investigation, challan has been presented.

In view of the aforesaid compromise, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
