The petitioner is alleged to be involved in a number of cases of theft of the vehicles. On 31.03.2016, he had been granted concession of interim temporary bail in order to watch the conduct of the petitioner.

On the instructions of SI Rupinder Singh, it has been informed that the petitioner did not indulge in similar activities after the interim order passed.

In view of the said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by him pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court subject to the conditions that he will not make any attempt to tamper with the evidence and will continue to appear before the trial Court.
