Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order/letter dated 3.1.2014 whereby on the basis of communication sent by SHO, Police Station Sandhour, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur and addressed to the Manager, HDFC Bank, Club Chowk, Malerkotla, the account No.50200002783325 of the petitioner was ordered to be freezed and the petitioner was not allowed to make any transaction in the said account.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jagpal Singh and on the basis of reply filed by way of affidavit of William Jeji, PPS, DSP, Malerkotla as well as letter Annexure R-3/T dated 11.4.2014, states that the

enquiry in the complaint has been conducted by SP(D), Sangrur and from the enquiry, it has emerged that the matter has been found to be of civil nature. Therefore, the transaction in the bank account No.50200002783325 which was freezed vide order dated 3.1.2014, has been ordered to be de-freezed and the petitioner has been allowed to operate the said account.

In view of the above stand taken by the respondent-State, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition as the prayer made by the petitioner no more survives.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
