Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Kuldip Singh in case FIR No.173 dated 30.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 506, 336, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act (Section 307 IPC deleted subsequently) registered with Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga.

It is submitted that the petitioner is alleged to have raised a *lalkara* and fired a shot from his revolver from a distance of 5/6 *karams* which hit the complainant on the back side of the right hand.

It is contended that the offence under Section 336 IPC is bailable whereas for the Arms Act revolver has already been recovered.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Raja Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 25th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
