This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147 dated 11.09.2015, under Sections 341, 342, 323, 506, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 307 of IPC has been added later on), registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 24.02.2016:-

“Counsel would inter alia contend that offence under Section 307 IPC has been added subsequently on account of an injury suffered by the complainant, Amritpal Singh and which was attributed to Gurjant Singh/non-applicant. It is further submitted that insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, the only overt act attributed is of having given a fist blow on Lakhwinder Singh.

Notice of motion, returnable for 18.05.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be

released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. He further submits that the investigation in the case is complete and even the challan has been presented on 16.04.2016.

In view of the above, prayer made in the petition is accepted.

Order dated 24.02.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
