Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.269 dated 29.09.2015, under Section 323/324/326/342/506/34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that it is a case of version and cross-version. Dispute between the parties is stated to have been settled and in pursuance to the compromise two separate petitions seeking quashing of the FIR as also the cross-version i.e. CRM Nos. M-11725 of 2016 and CRM No.M-11790 of 2016 have been filed in this Court and in which notice of motion has already been issued.

Petitioner has been in custody since 03.10.2015.

In the light of such peculiar circumstances noticed here-in-above, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
