The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. September 21, 2015 in a case registered on the basis secret information received by the police contending vague and general allegations that the petitioner alongwith 7/8 other co-accused have constituted a gang which indulged in various criminal activities.

So far as petitioner is concerned, he was involved in another case of similar nature. On the basis of his confession made, the petitioner has been arrested in this case.

Since no recovery connected with the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner had been affected, the involvement of the petitioner as per the allegations in secret information will certainly be a debatable issue. As one of the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail, the petitioner in said circumstance, can also be granted the concession of bail.

I have also considered the contention of learned counsel for the State that the co-accused of the petitioner after bailed out has not put in appearance before the Court. It is observe that the liberty of the petitioner may be safeguarded by imposing reasonable condition by the Court while releasing him on bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
