By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.218, dated 25.09.2015, registered under Section 409 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural).

It is contended that the petitioner is a depot holder. He never sold the kerosene oil at higher price than the prescribed price. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 28.03.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 28.03.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
