Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Satinder Singh alleging that he was taken to plot of Jagdip Singh and introduced to a lady who happens to be the petitioner. Petitioner was taken to her house where 4-5 girls and ladies were already present. Complainant was introduced to those girls and while the complainant was talking to the girls, fictitious police officials came and threatened the complainant that an FIR would be registered against him and the matter should be settled with the ladies. The amount of Rs.80,000/- was settled. A sum of Rs.40,000/- was paid. Remaining Rs.40,000/- was promised to be paid on 16.4.2015.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has not been attributed any role and that she is not known to any fictitious police official.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case and I am of the opinion that petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. It was her house which was used to introduce the complainant to the ladies named in the FIR .

No ground is made out for the grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. The petition is dismissed.

Nothing mentioned in this order will prejudice the right of the petitioner to seek concession of regular bail in accordance with law.
