Report dated 07.06.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Bakhshish Singh as well as of complainant Harjit Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3)**

RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.39 dated 14.05.2014 under Sections 420,120-B,406, IPC Police Station, Kahnwa, District Pathankot and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
