JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated January 04, 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has *inter-alia* contends that though a representation dated January 04, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.2 but even after the expiry of two months no action has so far been taken on the said representation.

2. Notice to respondent No.2 only at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied

to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated January 04, 2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
