While disposing of the appeal, the Co-ordinate Bench had directed that accused would surrender within a specified period.

Operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Coming to the order of learned trial court passed on 26.03.2004 on the quantum of sentence and considering all aspects of the case, the substantive sentence of seven years awarded to the appellant is reduced to four years. However, the imposition of fine of ₹ 2000/- and in default of payment of the same the direction to further undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for one month is upheld. The appellant is on bail, his bail bond, shall stand cancelled. The concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, shall get the convict arrested and commit him to prison for serving the remaining period of sentence and shall take necessary steps, to comply with the judgment, with due promptitude, keeping in view the applicability of the provisions of Section 428 Cr.P.C., and submit compliance report, to this Court, within a period of two months,

from the date of receipt of a copy thereof.

The District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana shall ensure that the directions are complied with, within the time frame, and the compliance report is submitted immediately thereafter.

The Registry shall keep track of the submission of compliance report, and will put up the papers whether the report is received or not within the time frame, immediately after the expiry thereof.”

Learned State counsel submits that one of the accused namely Kashmira Singh has died whereas the other accused namely Surmukh Singh has surrendered before the court concerned. This contention remains uncontroverted.

In view of the above, it appears that aforesaid order has been complied with.
