FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 11.03.2016 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant-Gaurav Kumar and the accused persons namely Alish @ Chinu, Digvijay @ Aman and Sandeep Dhuria @ Kala Dhuria, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.CX has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that being a matrimonial dispute, the offence for which the accused persons have

been hauled up is not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in "**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.49 dated 31.03.2014 registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib under Section 379 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the present petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
