This is an application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for restoration of CRM-M-814-2014, which was dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 15.01.2016.

Heard.

In view of the contents of the application, application is allowed and order dated 15.01.2016 is recalled and CRM-M-814-2014 is ordered to be restored at its original number and is taken up today.

CRM stands disposed of.

Main case

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought quashing of FIR No.183, dated 17.10.2012, under Section 61 (1) of the Excise Act and Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District

Fazilka alongwith all consequential proceedings arising thereto.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that petitioner has already been acquitted in the instant case bearing FIR No. 183, dated 17.10.2012.

3. In view of the acquittal of the petitioner by the trial court, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is disposed of accordingly.
