After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, counsel for the complainant and learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file. It is apparently a dispute arising out of family settlement dated 12.11.2008 and the alleged compromise arrived at between the parties on 20.07.2013. The petitioner, as per ASI Devinder Singh, has joined investigation. It is not a case of custodial interrogation and the dispute is apparently a civil dispute. In case, any element of criminal liability is there, the culpability of the petitioner will be determined during the course of trial which would certainly be a debatable issue.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 29.02.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or

hamper the investigation in any manner.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the parties to be determined by the civil Court or any other forum.
