The petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to hand over the investigation to some other independent agency i.e. CBI, Crime branch or through some higher police official in FIR No. 0001 dated 04.01.2016 under section 506 IPC 4 POSCO Act IPC Women Police Station Kurukshetra.

On notice, a reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra stating therein that on the complaint made by the petitioner that her daughter who is 16 years old was taken by one Lovepreet to Hotel Harsh, Kurukshetra under threat and raped her there. Because of fear, she brought jewellery of her mother weighing 5 tolas and gave it to accused Lovepreet. Dilpreet, Jasmeet and Simran who were hands in gloves with each other.

After the registration of FIR, investigation was carried out. Thereafter, accused Lovepreet was arrested on 02.11.2016 and was sent to judicial custody on 03.11.2016. Accused Dilpreet was arrested on 16.08.2016 and was released on bail by the Juvenile Justice Board, Kurukshetra.

Accused Anil Kumar, owner of Hotel Harsh, Kurukshetra was found innocent during the investigation. The other accused namely Jasmeet and Simran had already been arrested in case FIR No. 33 dated 07.12.2015 under Sections 328, 363, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 4 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act and under Section 67 A of the Information and Technology Act registered at Police Station Women, Kurukshetra.

On the statement made by the father of the petitioner, all the accused have now been arrested.

Learned State counsel on instructions has informed that they will file a challan within 15 days.

In view of the detail reply filed by the respondents, no further orders are required to be passed.
