Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused/petitioners- Mausin @ Bhola and Rahisu @ Sintu in case FIR No.691 dated 17.08.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 452, 395, 397, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC (Sections 395, 397, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on) and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Model Town, Panipat.

The petitioners along with other accused, on the intervening night on 16/17.08.2015 are alleged to have committed dacoity at the Dera and looted 8 buffaloes and 2 Oxes.

The petitioners along with two other co-accused were arrested on 01.09.2015 when they tried to sell of 4 looted buffaloes. Recovery of the canter used in the commission of offence as also country made pistol along with five live cartridges has been effected from the accused person.

It is contended that the petitioners are in custody since 01.09.2015 and the challan stands presented.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Subash Chander submits that apart from the allegations of the commission of present heinous crime, they are also involved in another FIR of the same nature.

Without commenting on merits of the case, keeping in view the nature of gravity of the alleged offences, no case for regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
