This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 31.05.2014 registered under Section 21 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Custody certificate filed in Court by way of affidavit of

Paramjit Singh Sandhu, Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar is taken

on record.

Today the learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar states that out of 10 witnesses 3 witnesses have already been examined and undertakes that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
