This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 3 to 6 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.7 to 9.

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 6, only at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sukant Gupta, Addl.P.P., UT, Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of UT Chandigarh, whereas Mr. R.P.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh as well as respondent No.4 - Senior

Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated February 24, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
