As already recorded in the order dated 17.02.2016, the services of the petitioner in this petition, i.e. Rajinder Singh, have been regularized by the respondents vide order dated 16.02.2016 (Annexure A-2 with the affidavit of the Secretary, Irrigation Department, Punjab, respondent No.1), dated 17.02.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition for grant of any date of regularization prior to the date already stated in the said order, i.e. w.e.f. 01.09.2005. However, he submits that the benefits flowing to the petitioner, in terms of the aforesaid order of regularization, be released to him.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions, submits that the respondents would have no objection on releasing the service and pensionary benefits to the petitioner in terms of the order of regularization, dated 16.02.2016, treating him to be regularized w.e.f. 01.09.2005.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid statements made on behalf of both the parties.

The service and pensionary benefits falling due to the petitioner, pursuant to his regularization w.e.f. 01.09.2005, be released to him within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
