The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 127 dated 17.09.2015 registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar under Sections 363, 366, 376, 34 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of SC and ST Act and Sections 4 and 5 of POCSO Act have been added later on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR has been registered after a gap of 9 days and the father had lodged a missing report which he had withdrawn later and had stated that he did not want any action against any one. Subsequently the case was registered. It was urged that Jagdeep had been granted anticipatory bail against whom there were similar allegations.

Learned State counsel urges that the girl was 15 ½ years old and the FSL report has been received and Amanpreet and Tinka had been named and the girl had accused both of them of enticing and raping her.

The petitioner is said to be the main accused and allegations of kidnapping and rape had been levelled against him. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
