Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Rashpal Singh, Police Station Sadar Banga submits that statements of the girl/petitioner No.1 as well as her mother/respondent No.4 have been recorded before the police, which have been placed on the record and which reflects that the threat to lives and personal liberty of the petitioners no more subsists.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, the petition stands disposed off. However, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the police by the petitioners, they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.
