This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 25.10.2012 passed by learned JMIC, Jalandhar and order dated 10.07.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, respectively vide which the learned Courts have dismissed the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning of the additional accused.

An FIR was registered by the petitioner levelling allegations against seven persons for demand of dowry and committing cruelty upon her. As per inquiry report submitted by ACP, Traffic, Jalandhar, Ajay Kumar Kawtra, Anju Jaitely, Sidharth Jaitley, Babbu, Rajinder were found innocent as they did not play any role in the commission of offence. An application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. was moved for summoning them as additional accused but it was also dismissed by Learned JMIC, Jalandhar, after going through the whole documentary evidence and statements of

witnesses and complainant/petitioner. Moreover, other witness appeared on behalf of prosecution namely Jaswant Singh but he said nothing against other accused except present accused/respondent No.1. The revision petition was also dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, after taking into consideration the evidence available on record.

In view of the above reasons and after going through the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in ***Hardeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2014 (3) SCC 92***, there is no ground is made out to interfere in the impugned orders dated 25.10.2012 and 10.07.2014 by way of this petition and the same is also dismissed as such.
