FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurdeep Singh, Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur, submits that the petitioner/girl as well as her mother respondent No.5 Kanta Rani both have made statements before the police, which have been placed on the record, and which shows that threat to the life and personal liberty of the petitioners no more subsists.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, the petition stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous. However, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the police by the petitioners, they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.
