However, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for exemption from personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court

Keeping in view the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the personal appearance of the petitioner is exempted subject to giving an undertaking that the statements of the witnesses would be recorded in her absence and in the presence of her counsel appearing before the trial Court or any other conditions, if any, to be imposed by the trial Court. The petitioner shall be present in case she is required by the trial Court. The petitioner shall also not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
