Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Harbans Singh in case FIR No.107 dated 01.10.2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 325, 452, 307, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

There is an eye-witness account of the complainant-Amandeep Kaur wife of Gurpreet Singh. The injured-Karamjeet Kaur is the widowed *Chachi* of her husband-Gurpreet Singh. The co-accused/non-applicant Harwinder Kaur and the present accused-Harbans Singh are the *Bhua* and *Phuphad* of her husband-Gurpreet Singh. There is a civil dispute regarding the property left behind by the deceased husband of the injured/*Chachi* Karamjeet Kaur, who has inherited his property being Class I legal heir whereas the aforesaid accused party claims the same on the basis of a Will.

On the day of occurrence, the present petitioner/accused-Harbans Singh, armed with a country-made pistol, is alleged to have entered

the house of Karamjeet Kaur and unsuccessfully fired upon her. Thereafter, when she ran to save herself, petitioner/accused-Harbans Singh is alleged to have chased her till the house of the neighbour and by pinning her down on the floor inflicted a *brick* blow on her mouth.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
