JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 50, dated 07.05.2010, under Sections 353, 186 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, Distt Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) and affidavit of the complainant/respondent No.2 dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-3).

2 Report of learned trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the parties have compromised the matter voluntarily with the intervention of respectables, without any inducement, threat or promise from any quarter. The same appears to be genuine.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another***; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, ***Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466*** and also in view of a division bench judgment of this High Court rendered in the case of ***Court on its own motion v. UT Chandigarh and others***; CWP No. 4964 of 2013 ***decided on 11.03.2013***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 50, dated 07.05.2010, under Sections 353, 186 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, Distt Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua petitioner.
