The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 263 dated 11.11.2014 registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib under Sections 307, 406, 498-A, 341, 323, 34 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are the married sister-in-law and the brother-in-law of the complainant and the allegations under Section 307 IPC were not levelled against them and they were living separately. He further contends that the complainant had alleged that the husband and Bholi had poured the mustard oil on the complainant. He further states that the husband has been arrested and Bholi is absconding and the trial will take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
