ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.885 dated 31.12.2014, registered under Sections 376-D IPC, Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 02.01.2015 and the trial is not concluding.

The State counsel submits that the victim was picked up and taken in a vehicle to an unknown destination and was raped and thereafter, she was left near the Maruti Agency and the co-accused is a proclaimed offender. The counsel also states that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded. Counsel further states that out of 17 prosecution witnesses, 10 PWs have been examined and one has been given up and the case is at the fag end of the trial.

The co-accused is a proclaimed offender. The prosecution has examined 10 witnesses. The allegations against the petitioner are serious. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
