FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 17.03.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Batala has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Gurvail Singh and the accused persons namely Malkeet Singh, Baldev Singh and Vikramjit Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a case of version and cross-version, the fact that parties belong to the same very area and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up

are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of DDR No.16 dated 04.12.2015 in FIR bearing No.65 dated 03.12.2015 registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Police District Batala under Sections 326/323/148/149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said DDR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
