This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.102 dated 09.06.2013 registered under Sections 365/34 IPC (Sections 302/201/380 IPC were added later on) at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody since 11.06.2013.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh states that only 6 witness remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.09.2016 (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
