This is the third petition filed by the accused-Charanjit Singh under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.132 dated 26.09.2014 for offence punishable under Sections 420 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 419, 465, 468, 471 IPC added later on 24.6.2015) registered with Police Station Ghoman, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner heard.

Previous application filed was got dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 06.01.2016. The order reads as under:-

“ *Present 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.132 dated 26.09.2014 for the offence punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ghuman, District Batala (Annexure P-1).*

The allegations against the petitioner are that he allured his complainant friend Dalbir Singh and received a sum of Rs.8 lacs for sending him abroad. There is specific allegation of money having been paid to the petitioner-Charanjit Singh.

The stand of the petitioner/accused-Charanjit Singh is that the entire payment was made to one Sarabjit Singh, who is engaged in the business of a Travel Agency. There have been many enquiries conducted in this issue. Some favouring the petitioner and some against the petitioner.

It is admitted fact that the earlier petition seeking anticipatory bail was dismissed on merits by this Court, vide order dated 31.10.2014.

Without issuing any notice, the State had been called upon to apprise the Court regarding the status of investigation. In compliance, status report by way of affidavit dated 06.01.2016 of Sh. Diljinder Singh, SSP, Police District Batala has been filed in the Court, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned opposite Counsel.

It transpires that the P.O. Proceedings have been initiated against the present petitioner-Charanjit Singh and the aforesaid Sarabjit Singh for not joining the process of law.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. ”

Since there is no change of circumstances, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
