The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.364 dated 09.09.2002, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra and order dated 26.04.2003 declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-4).

The marriage of the petitioner and respondent No.2 was solemnized on 22.02.1998 and one child namely Jaspreet Singh was born out of this wedlock. On account of harassment suffered by complainant-Sunita for demand of dowry, present FIR was registered. After registration of FIR (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender vide order dated 26.04.2003. At that time he was in Italy. Thereafter, the matter was compromised as per compromise deed dated 26.05.2014 (Annexure P-4).

In compliance of the order passed by this Court, status report has been sent by CJM, Kurukshetra. As per report, the petitioner did not appear for making statement with regard to compromise. However, complainant/respondent No.2-

Sunita had appeared before the Court on 06.04.2015 and made a statement that the

matter has been amicably settled between her and petitioner who was an accused and declared as a proclaimed offender. She further submitted that she is now residing with her husband-Ravinder Singh-petitioner in Italy after the compromise has been effected.

Keeping in view the statement made by complainant/respondent No.2 that dispute has been resolved between the parties amicably and she is residing with petitioner-Ravinder Singh in Italy, FIR No.364 dated 09.09.2002, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra and order dated 26.04.2003 declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender (Annexure P-2) are quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
