Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of ASI Shamsher Singh, on the basis of secret information that Sunil Kumar, Kavita and many other persons had appeared sureties in the Court at Mansa, on the basis of fake *jamabandis*, on receipt of money.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he is not named in the FIR. Allegations against him, as per the report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. are that he is alleged to have identified fake sureties, Sunil Kumar and Kavita in two criminal cases. The said persons have been granted concession of regular bail. Challan having been presented; petitioner being in custody with effect from 25.07.2015, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that petitioner will be debarred from appearing as surety in the District of Mansa for a period of five years.

The learned Sessions Judge will circulate a notice that petitioner is not permitted to act as a surety on behalf of any of the accused for a period of five years. He will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the proceedings in any manner.
