The petitioner has been in custody for the last one year and six months for having been found in possession of 195 strips of 10 tablets each of Alto-05 containing alprazolam and 145 strips of 10 tablets each containing Lorazepam.

As the prosecution agency has examined only three witnesses out of ten, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the prosecution agency shall produce the entire evidence within a period of six months after the next date of hearing. In case, the prosecution agency is not able to produce all the witnesses within said period, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
