HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for directing respondents No.1 to 5 to transfer the jail of petitioner from High Security Prison, Nabha to any other safe jail.

Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to provide proper security arrangements to the petitioner as he has a threat of life from gangsters of rival gang.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that the track record of the petitioner is altogether different. As many as 7 FIRs are registered against him and the offences referred in the said FIRs are serious in nature. It is an

admitted fact that the petitioner is lodged in High Security Jail, Nabha and, as such he is already under the supervision of concerned jail Superintendent. Therefore, plea of the petitioner that he be provided security, cannot be accepted.

In view of the above, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
