JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of cross version recorded vide DDR No. 37, dated October 06, 2008, under Sections 323, 324, 326 & 34 of IPC at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur arising out of FIR No.50, dated October 06, 2008, registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated February 29, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Mukerian, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with the intervention of the respectables, voluntarily, without any coercion or undue influence from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and cross version recorded vide DDR No. 37, dated October 06, 2008, under Sections 323, 324, 326 & 34 of IPC at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur arising out of FIR No.50, dated October 06, 2008, registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
