INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Daljeet @ Kalu has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.09 dated 08.01.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, under Sections 302 and 449 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

Police record has also been produced.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that this is second petition for bail. First petition for bail filed by the petitioner has been dismissed by this Court vide order dated 27.08.2015. It is a double murder case and the present petitioner is the main accused.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and also in view of the fact that there is no change in the circumstances, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, since the petitioner has been in custody since 06.03.2014, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires. Concerned Investigating Officer/Station House Officer is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before the learned trial Court at the earliest on the dates fixed.
