Prayer in this petition is for issuing direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to give police protection to the petitioners and also issue a direction to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the liberty and married life of the petitioners in any manner.

No one is present to represent the petitioners. Even on the last date also no one was present on behalf of petitioners. The order dated 29.2.2016 has not been complied with. The record further reveals that counsel for the petitioners has not

deposited the process fee and in this manner notices could not be issued to the respondents.

Therefore, the aforesaid conduct shows that the petitioners have no more interest to pursue the present petition. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
