JASPAL SINGH ,J.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No. 5 to 8.

2. The petitioners moved representation dated 05.01.2016 (Annexure P-7) to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.2, for getting the needful done, but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice to respondents No.1 to 4 only, at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record the photo stat copy of decree of divorce whereby pre-marriage of petitioner No.1-Gurpreet Singh with Sujana Kaur was dissolved by way of mutual consent.

6. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated 05.01.2016 (Annexure P-7) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

7. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or illegal.
